Anchored with the purpose of promoting library services and aiding young learners, the Isabela State University Cauayan Cluster Librarians (Cauayan, Roxas, and San Mateo Campuses) conducted their first-ever Radio broadcast on ISU Radio 107.9 FM, ISU Main Campus, Echague, Isabela, and the Extension Program at San Fabian Day Care Center, San Fabian, Echague, Isabela last June 21, 2023.

The ISU Cauayan Cluster Librarians—Miss Ivy Camille M. Gan, ISU Roxas Campus Librarian, Mrs. Kathleene M. Gonzales, ISU San Mateo Campus Librarian, and Mrs. Marilyn G. Subido, ISU Cauayan Campus Librarian—discussed the value of reading.

“Reading requires you to have the pa-

tience to build a cognitive perspective. This is considered to be a prime brain-stimulating activity to sharpen your mind. Individuals engaged in reading have a slower memory decline than those who avoid reading. It also improves memory and builds focus,” Mrs. Subido said during the broadcast.

In the afternoon, they went to San Fabian Day Care Center to conduct storytelling and book donations. The pupils, accompanied by their adviser, enjoyed the story told by the two BLIS students of ISU Echague and learned parts of the body in an action song led by Miss Diane Jean B. Gammad and Ms. Eliza M. Lara.

The library activity was made possible through the combined efforts of all ISU librarians, headed by the University Director for Library Services, Betsie M. Dela Cruz, RL, Ph.D.

ISU-CC Library hurdles AACCUP Accreditation Level IV, Phase I for BSIT and BEED Programs

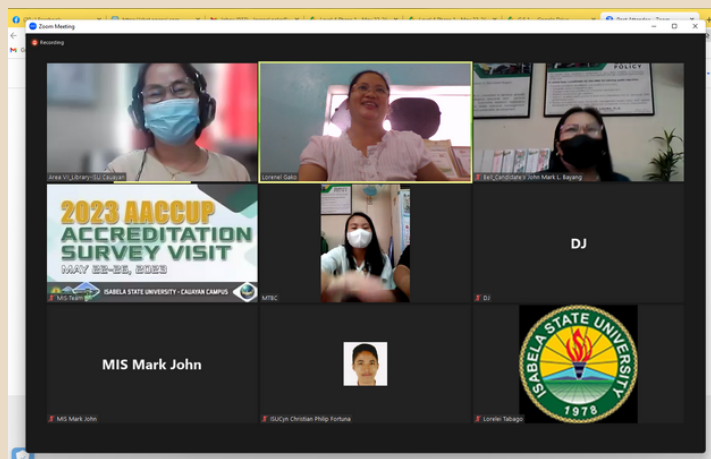
Accreditation is necessary to any person or institution in education that needs to prove that they meet a general standard of quality. Accreditation is one of the most challenging and tiring work especially in the preparation of documents, physical appearance of the library, arranging the collections or library resources and other supporting documents.

All library staff together with the head librarian participated in the preparation during the accreditation. They rendered over time in preparing documents and the library in order to have a good result in the accreditation. July 22, 2023, was the first day and opening of accreditation, all the documents had been presented to the accreditor. And July 25, 2023, was the final or last day of accreditation.

The chief of library services, Ms. Marilyn Subido together with her staff toured the accreditor through virtual visit. She toured to the E-library (admin building), CBM library and to the new library building. The accreditor said that as much as possible must occupy the new library building. She also suggested that the library should have stairs for disabled clientele or must have a special corner or place at the first floor of the building.

After the library tour, the library staff had joined to the Zoom meeting with the accreditor and everyone asked or interviewed during the meeting.

The accreditor proposed that the school should hire another librarian in order to meet the standards for the Philippine libraries. Which is in every one thousand (1,000) enrollees, one (1) full time head librarian, one (1) full time librarian and two (2) supporting staffs. She also asked about the salary of the licensed librarians and recommended that their salary must increase as per the salary of licensed librarian in the Philippines. The accreditor gave assurance that the library will pass the accreditation. The discussion ends meaningful and brought a sweet smile to everyone.

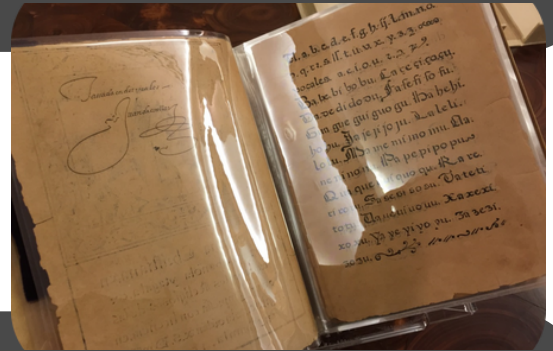

writing uniform in size, slant,

Librarians were once taught a special rounded style of handwriting to ensure uniformity and legibility in catalogs. The handwriting style, called the “library hand,” was developed by Thomas Alva Edison in 1885. Based on Edison’s own handwriting, the style was especially perfected to allow librarians to “take legibly from the wire, longhand, forty-seven and even fifty-four words a minute”.

The Doctrina Christiana was an early book of Roman Catholic catechism, written in 1593 by Fray Juan de Plasencia, and is believed to be one of the earliest books printed in the Philippines. The title literally means “Christian Doctrine”, and thus the primary goal of the book was to propagate Christian teaching across the Philippine archipelago.



The Museo-Biblioteca de Filipinas, is the first library in the Philippines. It was established on August 12, 1887 by a royal order of the Spanish government. It opened officially on October 24, 1891 at the Casa de la Moneda in Intramuros. It is now known as The National Library of the Philippines (NLP).

Currently, the world’s fastest reader is Maria Teresa Calderon from the Philippines. She is able to read 80,000 words per minute with 100% comprehension.

“In the time it takes for most people to read the label on a cereal box, fifteen-year-old Maria Teresa Calderon could read half a book, or more – if she didn’t have to turn the pages”, the Associated Press reported in 1968. At University, she read a three page long college-level essay of 3,135 words in just 3.5 seconds. In comparison, an average person reads around 250-300 words per minute, with around 70% comprehension.



There are “human libraries” around the world where you can check-out humans as a living book and listen to their unique life stories.

Started in Copenhagen in 2000 and now active in over 80 countries, The Human Library is an international organization focused on addressing people’s prejudices by helping them to talk to those they would not normally meet.

Many of the people you can “lend” are those who the society tends to stigmatize the most – and they often prove that you truly cannot judge a book by its cover.

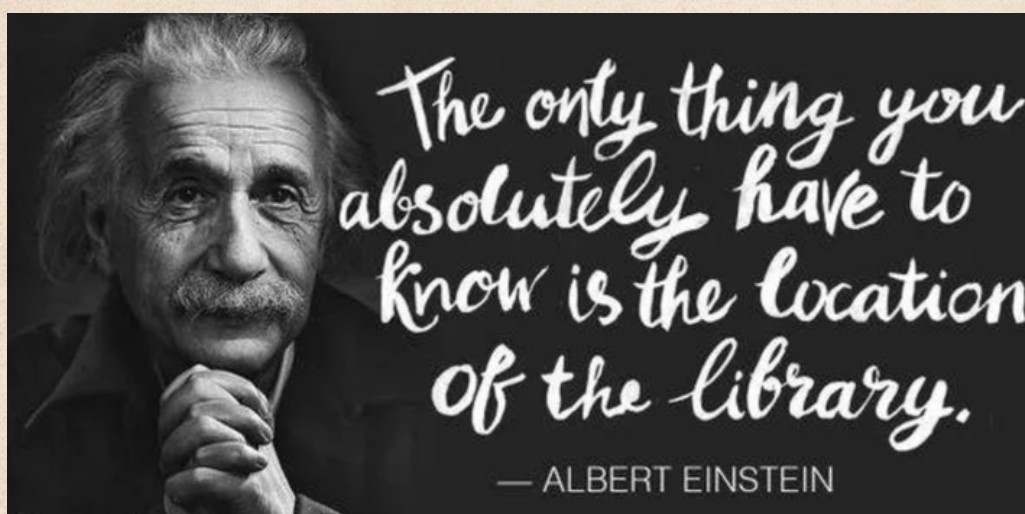
